Global Compact for Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration



Mandate for GCM follow-up and review GA resolutions 73/195 and 73/326

- Review to take place in the framework of the UN, through a State-led approach
- Participation of all relevant stakeholders (whole-of-society approach)
- Through intergovernmental measures
- UN regional economic commissions, among others, invited to review GCM implementation in respective regions
- IOM Director General, as Coordinator of the UN Network on Migration, upon request by Member States, to assist
- UN Network requested to collect all inputs as part of global knowledge platform


