Dear Stakeholders in the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) region,

I have the honour to inform you that the Regional Review of the Global Compact for Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration (GCM) in the UNECE region will take place on **12 and 13 November 2020**, **10:00 – 15:30 CET**. In view of the COVID-19 pandemic and associated travel restrictions in the UNECE region, we are proposing a virtual meeting (a logistics note will follow). A letter to Member States together with a concept note and agenda will be shared as well. They are available on the <u>website of the United Nations Network on Migration</u>. In addition, I would like to invite you to a Multi-Stakeholder Consultation in preparation of the Regional Review on **11 November 2020 from 10:00 – 13:00 CET**.

The intergovernmental meeting will consist of an opening segment, followed by four thematic roundtables, covering all 23 objectives of the GCM, and following General Assembly Resolution 73/326 on the modalities and organizational aspects of the International Migration Review Forum (IMRF). It will provide Member States and stakeholders with a space to present and review progress on GCM implementation. A summary report consisting of voluntary written submissions and outcomes of the intergovernmental meeting will be published and inform the IMRF.

I would like to invite interested Member States, stakeholders, representatives of relevant regional and cross-regional platforms and organizations to express their interest in participating in the opening session, the closing session, and in each of the roundtables as speakers and/ or moderators.

Given the new date for the review, we have extended the deadline for submissions of voluntary written submissions by Member States until **31 October 2020.** Submissions from all other stakeholders, also limited to 5,000 words, can be submitted by email: 2020GCMRegionalReviewUNECE@iom.int.. Please refer to the template and guidance.note on the Website of the UN Network on Migration for further information. Submissions will be made available ahead of the meeting on the website of United Nations Network on Migration.

Following the first regional stakeholder engagement webinar on GCM regional reviews in the UNECE region, which was held on 4 September 2020, I would also like to invite you to a second regional stakeholder briefing on **6 October 2020.** In this event, further details will be provided on the Multi-Stakeholder Consultations, including the agenda, logistics and registration process.
