Step 1: Open the Champion countries' discussion space

Open the page under "Migration Network Hub": <https://migrationnetwork.un.org/hub>

1. Select 'Migration Network Hub' from the main menu of the Network website.

Question 1. Are the GCM's 360-degree vision and guiding principles adequately reflected in the Guidance?

In accordance with the GCM's 360-degree vision, the guidance has been designed as a flexible, self-guided reference document that recognizes that there is no one-size-fits-all approach to GCM implementation. The guidance, 'Implementing the Global Compact for Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration (GCM): Guidance for governments and all relevant stakeholders', is comprised of two parts: a Guide, which provides an overview of the GCM and introduces a process to support governments and other stakeholders with GCM implementation; and a Booklet, which provides substantive information on all 23 GCM objectives, including examples of practical applications. In addition, the draft guidance includes explicit COVID-19 related content to support governments and other stakeholders incorporate COVID-19 considerations into GCM implementation, follow up, and review.

Question 1. Understanding the 360-degree vision and guiding principles of the GCM are critical to effective implementation, follow up and review efforts. Does the draft guidance material provide/strengthen the knowledge required to put these elements into practice? What would improve the material to help ensure that these elements are effectively incorporated into GCM implementation, follow up and review, including in the development of National Implementation Plans (NIPs)?

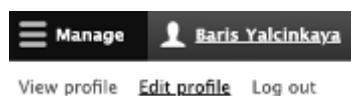
