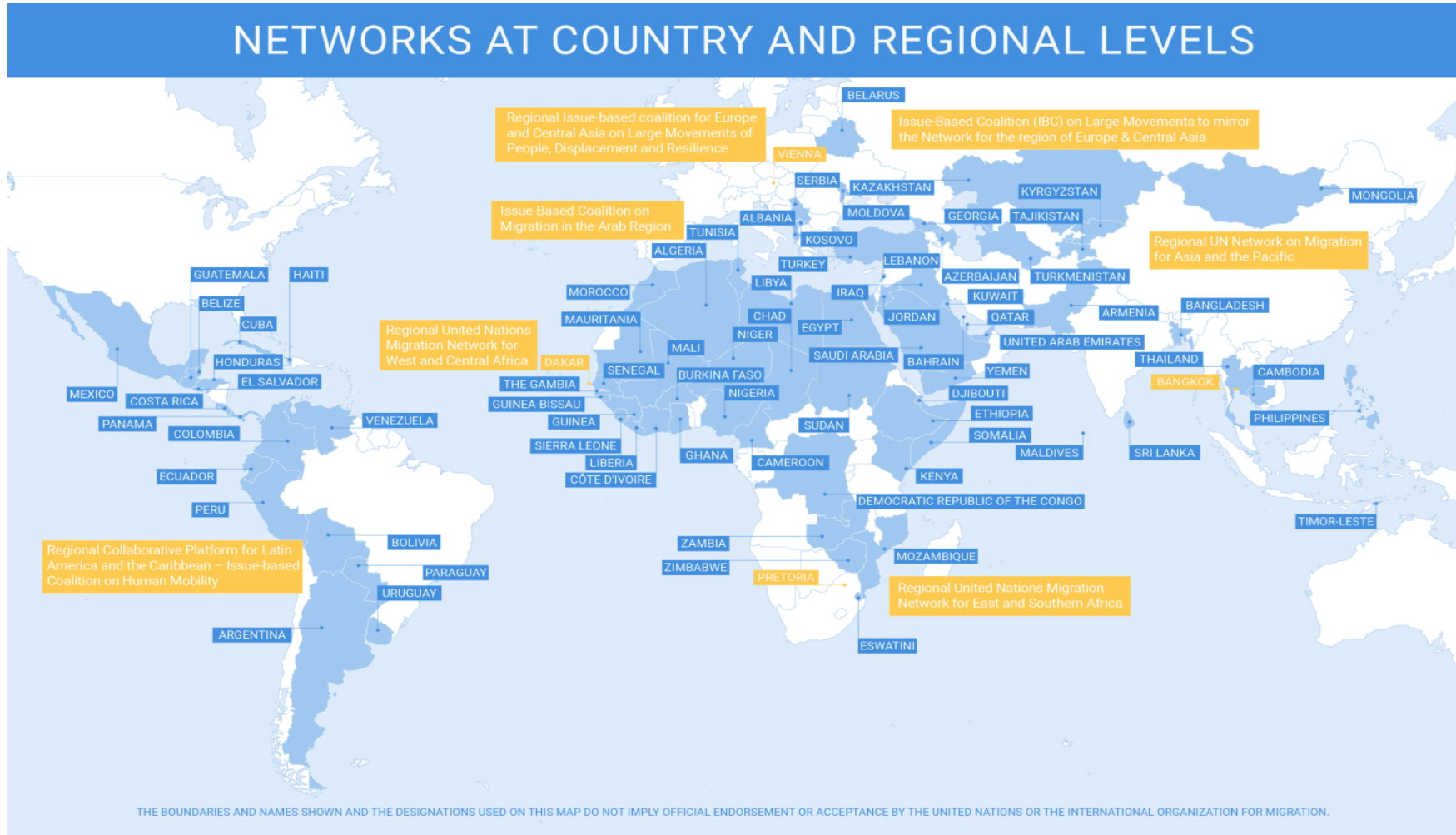


INTERNATIONAL MIGRATION REVIEW FORUM 2022

2. Actionable recommendations on missing migrants and providing humanitarian assistance to migrants in distress

Activities:

- 1 Conduct a mapping of existing promising practices (including in relation to the implementation of relevant commitments contained in Objective 8 of the GCM) to be hosted on the Migration Network Hub to inform and substantiate more targeted and actionable recommendations.
Timeline: 2022 - 2023 - 2024
- 2 Convene a comprehensive consultation process, including by organizing a series of hybrid or virtual consultations at regional or cross-regional ('route based approach') levels and to seek feedback on the content and prioritization of possible recommendations.
Timeline: 2022 - 2023 - 2024
- 3 Develop a set of draft recommendations for Network and stakeholder feedback.
Timeline: 2022 - 2023 - 2024
- 4 Consolidate feedback and submit a final draft for the SG's consideration.
Timeline: 2022 - 2023 - 2024
- 5 Prepare advocacy and communications materials to support the dissemination of the SG's actionable recommendations, including as part of the Network commitment to speak with "One Voice".
Timeline: 2022 - 2023 - 2024

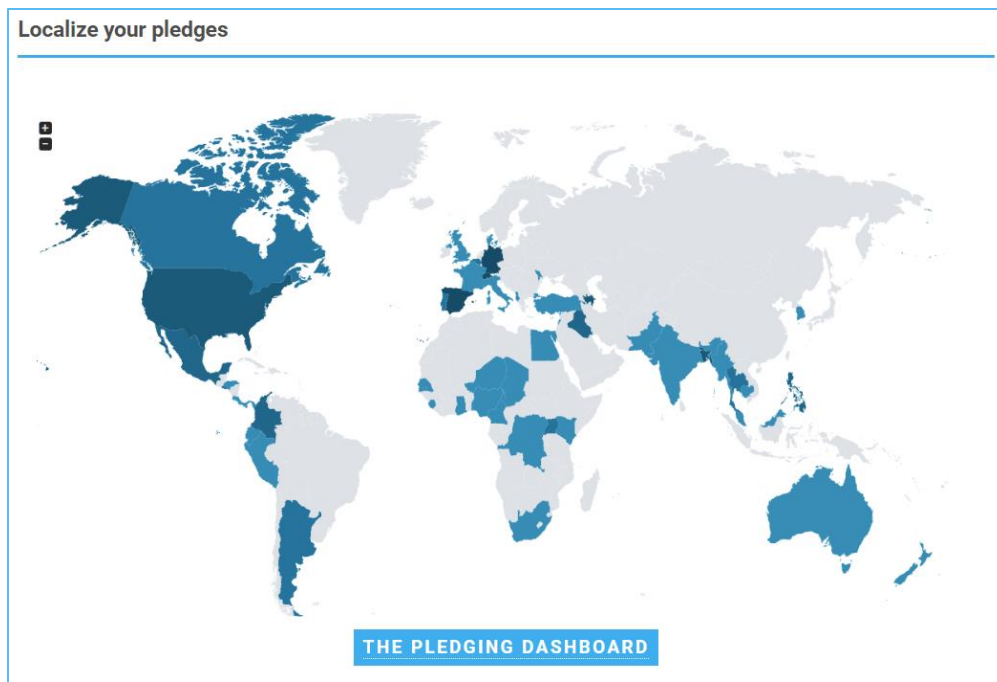

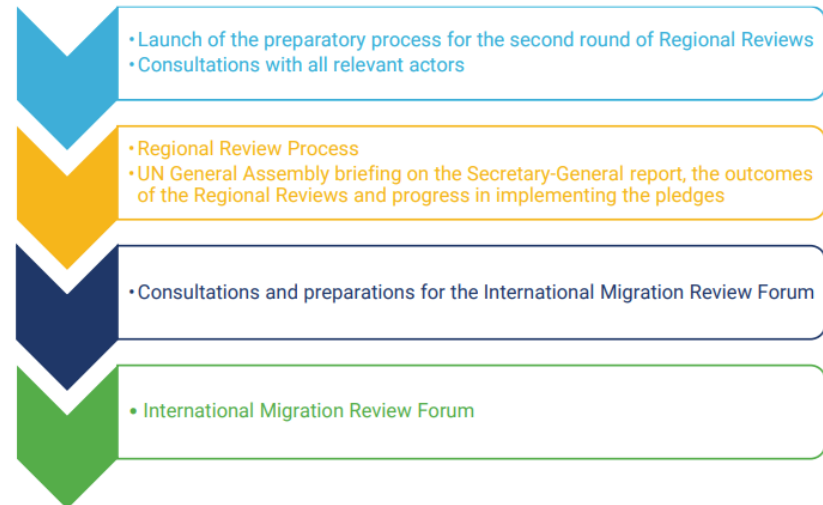
