

Call for Application for Stakeholders

Stakeholders' engagement at the Informal plenary meeting of the General Assembly in order to consider the biennial report of the Secretary-General on the implementation of the Global Compact on Migration

Thursday 5 December, 10.00-13.00 and 15.00-18.00, Trusteeship Council Chamber,
United Nations Headquarters, New York.

Overview

This note outlines the key steps proposed to ensure the active participation of stakeholders at the informal plenary meeting of the General Assembly in order to consider the biennial report of the Secretary-General on the implementation of the Global Compact for Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration (GCM).

Background

The GCM requests the Secretary-General (SG) to report on the progress of GCM implementation and its objectives, the activities of the UN system in this regard and the functioning of the institutional arrangements. The report builds on the inputs from Member States, UN system entities, stakeholders, and country and regional Networks. The GCM Guiding Principle of a whole-of-society approach promotes meaningful engagement of stakeholders in all stages of implementation, follow-up and review.

We will circulate the report as it is made available by the General Assembly.

Criteria for the application

All stakeholders:

- Should be engaged in activities related to GCM implementation and review.
- Should represent one of the different sectors listed in para. 44 of the GCM:
 Civil society, migrant and diaspora organizations, trade unions, faith-based
 organizations, the private sector, local authorities and communities,
 parliamentarians, academia, National Human Rights Institutions, the International
 Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement, media.





Gender, residence-base, relevant work background in the region, and sector balance will be considered for the selection. Approximately 20 (TBC) stakeholders will be selected. Stakeholders are invited to express interest to make interventions from the floor.
