Inspiring practices from the region

Brazil

- Since 2018, the Consejo Municipal de Inmigrantes (CMI) in São Paulo promotes political participation of migrants at the local level through voting and inclusion in policymaking processes
- The CMI consists of 32 counselors who serve two-year terms and work with the local government

Argentina & Chile

- Since 2021, the "Juntos a la par, apoyo a migrantes con discapacidad" initiative from Incluyeme.com has trained 183 migrants with disabilities and 20 have found employment
- Available courses: graphic design, programming, software testing, virtual assistant, and more
