

## Online form for Expression of Interest to receive funding support to attend the Africa Regional Review of the GCM

The Global Compact for Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration (GCM) Regional Review for the Africa Region will be held from 8-10 October 2024 in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. A limited amount of funding is available under the Migration Multi-Partners Trust Fund's funding window for the GCM follow-up and review to support stakeholder participation in the regional reviews. This form is for stakeholder representatives to submit their Expression of Interest to be considered for funding support to travel to and stay in Addis Ababa at attend the Regional Review meetings from 8-10 October 2024.

**The deadline to submit this form is 4<sup>th</sup> September 2024.**

### Selection criteria:

- **All applicants must have submitted their registration for the Africa Regional Review by the 3<sup>rd</sup> September deadline. The registration can be found [here](#).**
- Applicants should represent an organization or entity based in and/or working in the Africa region.
- Applicants should be actively engaged in activities related to GCM implementation and review.
- Priority will be given to the following sectors in alignment with para. 44 of the GCM:
  - Grassroots civil society organizations;
  - Migrants and their organizations, including of migrant youth, women and/or migrant workers;
  - Diaspora networks.

### Selection process:

- Selection of a limited number of funded participants will be made in alignment with the above criteria and in consideration of a balance of sub-regional, sectoral and gender representation.
- Selection will be made by members of the Africa regional UN Network on Migration.
- Notifications on funding will be communicated to all applicants approximately on 9 September 2024.
