



Roadmap: Stakeholder Engagement in the Second Round of Regional Review processes

Preparatory Process

Multi-stakeholder consultations

- The Network secretariat facilitated two virtual global stakeholder consultations on 31
 October (for the African, Latin American and Caribbean, and European regions) and 1
 November 2023 (for the Asia-Pacific and Middle East-North Africa regions). The
 consultations provided briefings by each regional UN Network and drew feedback from
 stakeholders on the process and desired outcomes for the second round of Regional
 Reviews.
- The Network secretariat, in collaboration with the regional Network, will facilitate one
 virtual stakeholder pre-consultations for each region, at least twelve weeks prior to
 each Regional Review, in order to draw inputs early on in the process which would feed
 into the inter-governmental review meeting discussions, the agenda of the multistakeholder consultation and to strengthen stakeholder participation in the Regional
 Review process.
- The regional Network members are encouraged to facilitate thematic consultations as part of the drafting process of the background notes for each thematic roundtable in the inter-governmental review meeting. This could include discussions on the thematic priorities, progress and gaps on implementation; and to strengthen regional stakeholder engagement mechanisms and country level engagement.
- The Network will support the organization of one in-person continental multistakeholder consultation for each region. In order to maximize in-person interaction among stakeholders, Member States and UN entities, the multi-stakeholder consultation could be organized one day prior to the review meeting, subject to feedback and inputs received by stakeholders on the organizational aspects.
- All stakeholder consultations will provide interpretation in relevant UN languages and the Network will disseminate relevant materials well in advance of any meetings.

Regional Stakeholder Engagement

Regional Network stakeholder engagement mechanisms or advisory groups play a lead
role in consulting regional stakeholders to design agendas, preparatory activities and
priorities in each region. Where such mechanisms do not exist, regional Networks with
their stakeholders can design an inclusive process to gather inputs from regional and
national stakeholders.
