Background information

- 1) On 10-13 May 2022, Member States will meet in New York for the first International Migration Review Forum (IMRF) to discuss the implementation of the Global Compact for Safe, Orderly and Regular Migration (GCM)
- 2) [UNMN](#) should support Kazakhstan to prepare for the [IMRF](#). This can include:
 - Voluntary national reviews.
 - In-person participation at the IMRF of national authorities using MPTF funding.
 - Gathering and provision of good practices and challenges in GCM implementation.
 - Mobilizing governments and stakeholders to engage fully in [IMRF preparations](#).

UNMN Achievements

- ✓ In May 2020 the [UN Network on Migration in Kazakhstan Terms of Reference](#) (TOR) was submitted
- ✓ In March 2021 the first [Voluntary national report](#) was submitted by the Government of Kazakhstan
- ✓ The National UNMN interdepartmental working group under the Ministry of Labor and Social Protection of the Population was established
- ✓ The National UNMN Workplan is under development
- ✓ 2 MPTF project proposals (regional and national) are submitted

Topics for discussion: suggested UNMN actions

- To hold online meeting of the National UNMN interdepartmental working group under MoL scheduled on November 24, 2021
- To provide technical support for KZ GOV in preparation of the second Voluntary national report on GCM until February 2022
- To provide training for state authorities and stakeholders on GCM implementation
- To arrange bilateral meetings between UNMN co-chairs and the Minister of Foreign Affairs to discuss and encourage in-person participation at the IMRF by high-ranking KZ GOV officials
