



International Migration Review Forum 16-20 May 2022, United Nations Headquarters, New York

Information for registered stakeholders

1. Overview and format of the Forum

The inaugural IMRF will take place from **17 to 20 May 2022**, under the auspices of the General Assembly at United Nations Headquarters in New York, preceded by a one-day informal interactive multi-stakeholder hearing, which will be held on **16 May 2022**.

2. Access to UN buildings

Special Event Tickets (SETs) are required for entry into the UN Headquarters for the entire week of the IMRF (**16 - 20 May 2022**, from **09:00** to **18:00**). The SETs will be distributed by the Office of the President of the General Assembly and the United Nations Network on Migration secretariat. Only stakeholders in receipt of a registration confirmation may collect a name-specific SET. You cannot designate someone to attend in your place.

Stakeholders are invited to **collect their Special Event Tickets (SETs)** on any of the following days:

- **Saturday, 14 May from 15:00-17:00**, outside of the UNHQ visitors entrance located at 46th Street and 1st avenue (right side of the entrance)
- **Sunday, 15 May from 15:00-17:00**, outside of the UNHQ visitors entrance located at 46th Street and 1st avenue (right side of the entrance)
- **Monday, 16 May from 8:30-10:00**, outside of the UNHQ visitors entrance located at 46th Street and 1st avenue (right side of the entrance).

Stakeholders may access UN Headquarters at 46th Street and 1st Avenue: Public entrance. Please be reminded that your passes are personalized.

All participants must bring a government issued photo ID from UN member States and proof of vaccination for entry to the UN complex.

Please be aware of the following: Do not attend if you are feeling unwell or if you are having flu like symptoms. If you start feeling unwell during the event you must immediately leave the

complex and seek medical help. International travelers must familiarize themselves with local travel guidelines and requirements.

3. Seating arrangements

In the Informal Multi-Stakeholder Hearing there will be an informal seating arrangement on a first-come, first-served basis.

For the roundtables, the policy debate and the plenary, SETs do not guarantee a seat in meeting rooms. Adequate space will be reserved in the balcony for non-governmental stakeholders on a first come, first served basis. Security Officers on site may advise when rooms reach capacity. **Secondary tickets** may be distributed to non-governmental stakeholders at the entrance of each meeting room of the Forum on a first come, first served basis, to effectively control the room capacity
